

Monitoring of Paramount Resources

MAY 30 2006

Project Overview:

With the increase of oil and gas activity, this on site project was to oversee and understand the activities and possible effects to the environment and wildlife of the area. The Cameron Hills Project was reviewed; a security gate was set up for monitoring trucks and visitors in and out of location. The roads were maintained for winter conditions to facilitate the increase of delivery trucks to the operation site. This on site daily monitoring will increase our knowledge of the activities of the land changes and movement of the wildlife in the plant location.

Project Activities:

George Lafferty had a training course with Chris Harron for water sampling and CPS reporting they did a quick overview of taking pictures and reporting of what was taking place at the site. Weekly visits to the site were monitored and records of each visit were submitted to the Hay River Metis Council for review. Danny Beck our former President was in contact with George Lafferty every week to get the updated reports. All the information was then past on to the executives' and board members at there meetings.

Project Results:

MARCH 09TH 2006

Left Hay River at 6:30 am arrived at Indian cabins at 8:10 am. Mileage is 136.9 km from Hay River. It is 138.2 to the Paramount turn off from Hay River. Security gate is 141.8 km from Hay River.

Start heading west for approx. 40 km winter road is in excellent condition, no garbage on roads. No visible signs of creeks or water crossings, winter road is on old existing cut lines. Arrived at plant site, mileage is 177.3 km, checked in with Paramount personnel at control room. I told them who I was and what I was doing there. They were very helpful and friendly, and I was told to check in when I was leaving area.

Water is trucked in by Keith's Water Service from Hay River, Raw sewage is hauled out to Indian Cabins, and garbage dumpster is from High Level and hauled out. Continued on to the second camp, Rowe's Construction from Hay River the camp site was clean and the surrounding areas. Camera was dead so I did not take pictures this trip and forgot the GPS as well.

MARCH 14TH 2006

Left Hay River at 10:00 am arrived at Paramount turn off it was snowing, took pictures of roads, pipeline sites, camp sites, rig sites, entrance site, security gate. The roads were graded and open for hauling equipment and camp sites were clean not very much movement on the site as the weather was cold.

FIRST TRIP MARCH 09TH 2006
